
## ISSUE IN AGRICULTURE MECHANIZATION (NO. 1):

### **CAUSES**

- ➤ Poor distribution of machinery
- ➤ Inexperienced stakeholders

  (eg. Operators, mechanics, technicians, fabricators managers/owners etc)
- ➤ Absence of spare parts
- ➤ Inadequate AMSECs
